Re: Notice of Assessment Monitoring Program pursuant to 40 CFR 257.94(e)(3) and 257.105(h)(5)

Date: August 3, 2018

Choctaw Generation Limited Partnership, LLLP – Red Hills Operation (Red Hills), located in Ackerman, Mississippi, operates a single unit electrical generation facility designed to generate electricity for dispatch to the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) electrical system. Red Hills owns and operates an existing Ash Management Unit (AMU) required to meet the requirements for landfills under the Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule of 40 CFR 257, Subpart D.

Per the requirements of 40 CFR 257.94(e), if the owner or operator determines pursuant to 40 CFR 257.93(h) that there is a statistically significant increase (SSI) over the background level for one or more of the constituents listed in Appendix III to Part 257 at any monitoring well at the waste boundary, the owner or operator must prepare a notification stating that an assessment monitoring program has been established. As a result of detection monitoring conducted at the site, Red Hills determined that there was an SSI above background levels and established an assessment monitoring program. Red Hills will complete the notification requirement of 40 CFR 257.94(e)(3) by placing this notice in the facility's operating record on or before September 2, 2018, within 30 days of establishing the assessment monitoring program, as required by 40 CFR 257.105(h)(5).
